

Cable Scarf Pattern

What You Need:

Trendsetter "Aura" 3 balls (or 450 yards of same gauged yarn)
 One pair of #10 1/2 16" Circular or straight needles
 Or size needed to obtain gauge
 Scissors
 Tape measure
 Ring Markers
 Cable Hook

Gauge:

14 stitches = 4 inches on size 10 1/2 needles 3.5 stitches per inch

What You Need to Know:

M1 = make 1 stitch by knitting into the bar in between stitches.

Instructions:

With #10 1/2 needle cast on 44 stitches loosely. Work as follows:

Row 1, 2 & 3

Slip 1 stitch as if to purl, then knit to the end

Next row (RS):

Set up cable as follows: Slip 1, Knit 16, P2 (K1, M1) 6 times, P2, Knit 17 (52 stitches)

Next row: knit

Now work 14 rows of cable pattern as follows:

Row 1	Slip 1, knit 16, P2, K12, P2, knit 17
Row 2	Slip 1, knit 18, P12, K19
Row 3	same as 1
Row 4	same as 2
Row 5	same as 1
Row 6	same as 2
Row 7	Slip 1, knit 16, P2, slip 6 stitches on cable needle and hold in front, K6, K6 from cable needle, P2, knit 17
Row 8	same as 2
Row 9	same as 1
Row 10	same as 2
Row 11	same as 1
Row 12	same as 2
Row 13	same as 1
Row 14	same as 2

Continue as established, always working the 12 stitch cable over center 12 stitches. When 1" shorter than desired length (usually 64") ending on a WS row work next row (RS) row; Slip 1, knit 16, P2, (K2tog) 6 times, P2, knit 17. Now work 3 rows garter stitch (all knit) and bind off loosely in pattern stitch. Weave ends. Viola!
